19th Dec 1877 Properties for Sale Plumer

Mr Plumer is favoured with instructions by the Trustees of the late Mrs Dendy Sadler, to sell by Auction at the King's Head Hotel, Horsham, on Wednesday 19th December 1877 at two o'clock:

Lot 1 - a very desirable and most substantial freehold private residence with double frontage, very valuable for converting into business premises, in the occupation of G Bishopp, Esq. Lot 2 - adjoining the preceding lot the conveniently arranged offices and Lot 3 - also adjoining, a most desirable piece of freehold building ground.

On the same day property of Mr Honywood was for sale, and also a meadow at Five Oaks.

On 22nd December, it was reported that Lot 1 was purchased by Mr Bishopp, Surgeon for £1,500. The property of Mr Honywood was sold, lots 3 and 4 to Mr Wood for £150 each lot, lot 6 to Mr P Chasemore at £150 and lot 13 to Mr Edward Bostock at £250. It is not clear from this whether the other lots in the sale were actually sold!
